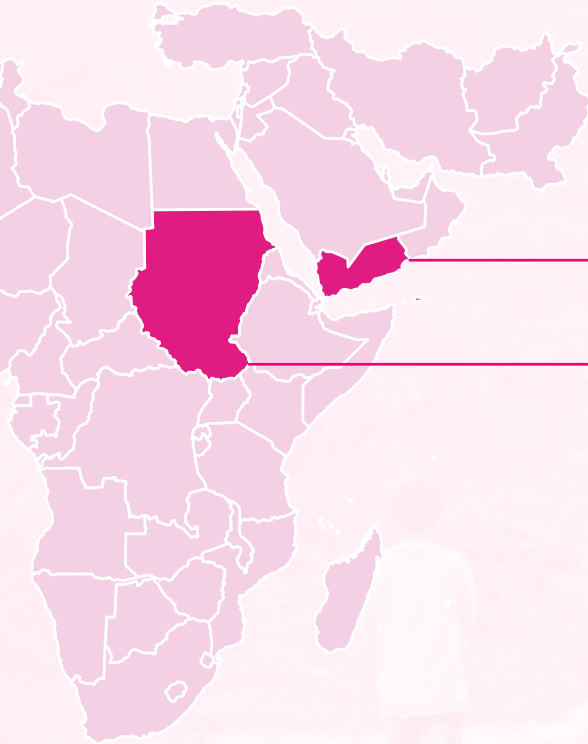
The Australian branch has expanded to Malawi!

We have paused fundraising for Sudan and Yemen as there is no way for us to safely transfer the funds and restart the programmes.
